### The Direct Debit Guarantee



- . This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit PSL re IWGB will notify you five (5) working
  days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request PSL re IWGB to collect a payment,
  confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by PSL re IWGB or your bank or building Society, you are entitled to
  a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society
- If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when PSL re IWGB asks you to
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building Society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.

- Since our foundation in 2013, we've represented scores of members at disciplinaries and grievances – saving jobs, ending bullying and building confidence.
- Through the IWGBsupported 3 Cosas campaign, outsourced workers at the University of London, LSHTM and the Royal College of Music now get proper sick pay and holiday pay. We're now taking this fight to other Universities in London too.
