Essentially, the VCEG had decided to implement the LLW in stages.

The upgrade dates would be:

1 Oct

1 Jan

1 July.

At each, the upgrade would be (roughly) 50-55p per hour for staff on the lowest rate and differentials will be maintained.

In the recent IWGB ballot, Security Officers voted <u>100% YES</u> to strike action.
